In Kindergarten, we will learn so much!

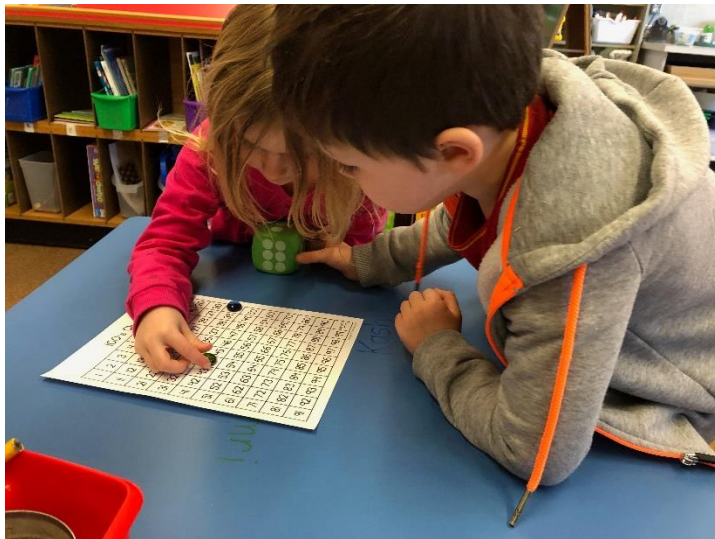
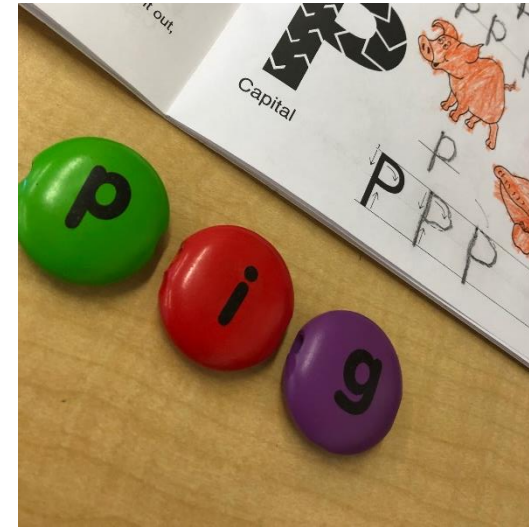
We will do work, we will do circle time and we will do fun art activities.

We get to learn new games in the Gym.

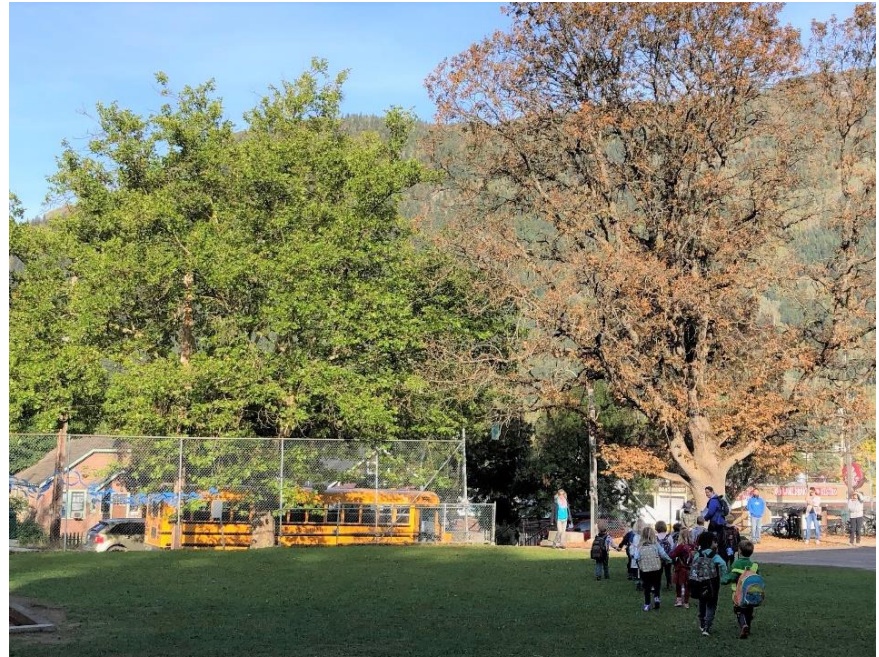


We also get to do movement activities in the Studio.
